De Groot's preferred way to relax from the repetitive and concentrated work on Thesis was to design more fonts – typefaces of a kind he described as 'fun fonts'. [← ↓ Nebulae Four](#)

Many of these were quick-and-dirty 'destructive' fonts, often obtained by putting the Thesis curves through one or more filters in a vector drawing program. [← Nebulae Two](#)

Others were more sophisticated. [← Nebulae ThreeDee](#)

Nebulae is one of De Groot's more playful creations, [← Nebulae One](#)

that made it into FSI's Fontfont type library and later, after he had decided to transfer all his typefaces to his own company, into the LucasFonts collection. Nebulae is based on TheSans, dissolving into clouds of amorphous spots. [← Three / One →](#) Each of Nebulae's four fonts has a different density; by superimposing various versions of the same text in different colours, dazzling effects can be obtained.

A fifth font, Nebulae ThreeDee, [← ThreeDee](#) adequately impersonates a three-dimensional fuzzy alphabet. [← Nebulae Four](#)
